Workshop I - You and Your Neighborhood
Thursday, April 14, 2016 (Training Room A)

Participants will learn about the resources available for leaders to expand communication throughout their neighborhoods & will develop a survey that will help them better understand their neighborhood needs and concerns.

Workshop II - Neighborhood Leadership & Identity

Participants will learn the importance of building relationships and partnerships with other leaders in the community for the betterment of their neighborhood and discuss the characteristics of an effective leader.
