## Follow these guidelines:

- ❖ Keep it simple. Too many pictures or words may distract from the message.
- ❖ All words must be spelled correctly.
- ❖ Drawings should be landscape (horizontal), NOT vertical. See diagram.
- ❖ Entries must be mailed or delivered flat by March 4, 2016.

- Check off a slogan or write one of your own.
- Make sure your drawing is in color and is in landscape format.
- Be sure words on drawing are spelled correctly and printing is neat.
