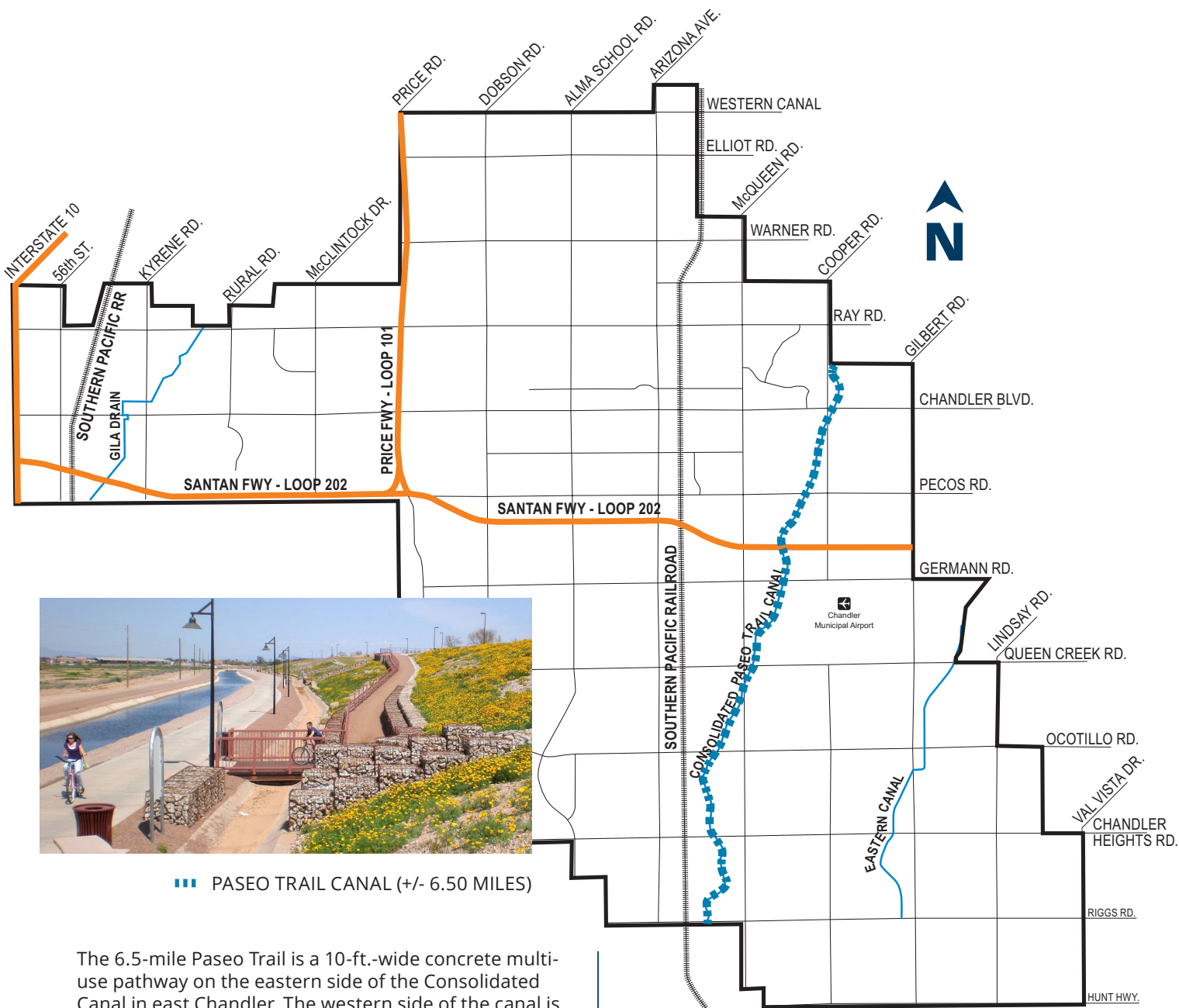


PASEO TRAIL

Trail begins at Galveston Street and continues to Riggs Road



■ ■ ■ PASEO TRAIL CANAL (+/- 6.50 MILES)

The 6.5-mile Paseo Trail is a 10-ft.-wide concrete multi-use pathway on the eastern side of the Consolidated Canal in east Chandler. The western side of the canal is a surface in most areas that can be used for horseback riding. The trail begins at Galveston St. and continues south to Riggs Road.

The Paseo Trail is popular with walkers, joggers, stroller-pushers, bicyclists, and even horseback riders (west side of the canal only). It is also an alternative transportation route for people who work and live near the trail.

The trail is also part of an interconnected series of trails along the Consolidated Canal through Chandler, Gilbert, and Mesa.

Parking for the Paseo Trail system is at:

Paseo Vista Recreation Area | 3850 S. McQueen Road

Tibshraeny Family Park | 270 N. Cottonwood St., at the northern trailhead

Tumbleweed Park | 2250 S. McQueen Road, on the east side, via the Los Arboles Park connection.

These parks have parking lots and restrooms for patrons to use.
