Where exactly is Tumbleweed Park?

Answer: [Tumbleweed Park](#) (2250 S. McQueen Rd., Chandler 85286) is located on the southwest corner of Germann & McQueen Roads, just south of the 202 San Tan Freeway.

Where can I park and how much does it cost?

Answer: Parking costs \$5 per vehicle (CASH ONLY). You may park on the southwest corner of Germann & McQueen Roads - enter from McQueen Road (near the Tennis Center) or at the lot off of Hamilton Street - enter off of Hamilton Street and Germann Road (at the corner of the Park & Ride).

Do you have disabled parking and how much does it cost?

Answer: Parking costs \$5 per vehicle (CASH ONLY). Disabled parking is available on the southwest corner of Germann & McQueen Roads - enter from McQueen Road (near the Tennis Center) or at the lot off of Hamilton Street - enter off of Hamilton Street and Germann Road (at the corner of the Park & Ride). Parking attendants will direct vehicle to designated lots. Vehicles must have disable plates or placard.

Where do I enter the event at?

Answer: The park is open and you may enter from your designated parking lot into the event area.

Will beer be sold at the event?

Answer: No, beer will not be sold at the event. No alcohol, of any kind, is allowed at the event. Only non-alcoholic drinks may be consumed at the event.

Can I B-Q-Q on my own grill?

Answer: No, you cannot grill at the park. Open flames are not allowed in the park whether they are in park grills or personal grills.

Can I bring my own food to the event?

Answer: Yes, you can. Please make sure to bring all food pre-cooked.

Can I bring drinks from home?

Answer: Yes, you can bring in sealed bottle water, sports drinks, or sodas. Please make sure to leave all other beverages at home. These beverages must be in cans or plastic bottles. Glass containers are not permitted.

Can I bring a cooler from home?

Answer: Yes, you can. Please make sure to leave any alcohol beverages and glass containers at home. Security and staff will be monitoring the event for outside alcohol. They may ask to inspect your cooler and if prohibited items are found, the product will be disposed of immediately.

Will there be any food or drinks available for purchase at the event?

Answer: Yes. Vendors will be on site selling food, snacks, and non-alcohol and alcoholic drinks.

Can I bring lawn chairs or blankets to sit on?

Answer: Yes, you can. It is encouraged that chairs and blankets are used by guests since only grass seating is available.

Can I bring an umbrella or pop up canopy with me?

Answer: Yes, you can. Please make sure to have someone stay with the equipment at all times. Canopies are not allowed to be staked into the ground. Please be diligent if there are windy conditions. We hold the right to ask you to take down your umbrellas and canopy if we deem they are unsafe.

Can I bring my dog with me?

Answer: Yes, you can, as long as your pet stays on its leash. It is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** that dogs stay home due

to the large crowds and noise from the fireworks.

Will there be any music or stage entertainment?

Answer: Yes, there will be music and a DJ throughout the event duration.

What time do the fireworks start?

Answer: 9 p.m. and should last approximately 20 minutes

Can we set off fireworks in the park or parking lots?

Answer: No. Fireworks of any kind are not allowed at this event, in the park, or parking lots. This includes sparklers!

How will you notify the public if the fireworks are cancelled?

Answer: We will only cancel the fireworks show if the wind prohibits us and it is determined by the Fire Department to be unsafe.
