

These approaches will maintain the viability of employment corridors and plan for the use of remaining unbuilt properties. Mobility includes bicycling, autonomous vehicles, new transit modes, business aviation, traffic technologies and safety enhancements.

- High-tech, multi-modal transit options for residents and visitors
- Safe, attractive and well-managed roadways and traffic systems

- Regional resources that maximize Chandler's ability to finance transportation projects

Chandler boasts a mixture of modern homeowner associations, mature traditional neighborhoods, apartments, condominiums and other housing types. - Well-maintained and enhanced infrastructure that promotes aesthetics, safety and community vitality






Quality of Life
