intel **Intel:** Has approximately 12,000 employees in Chandler between campuses in the Price Corridor and West Chandler. Intel is currently building two new semiconductor fabrication facilities, representing a capital investment of at least \$17 billion. The project is expected to add 3,000 employees.



Microchip Technology: Headquartered in Chandler with approximately 1,500 employees. Microchip is a leading provider of smart, connected and secure embedded control solutions. The company has continued to expand its Chandler operations, most recently adding a four-story, 272,000 SF building in 2018.

NXP **NXP:** Has approximately 1,500 employees at its campus in Uptown Chandler. NXP recently invested \$100 million to make its facility one of the most advanced gallium nitride semiconductor factories in the world. The site supports a range of uses and is now equipped to supply components for emerging 5G applications.

ARM **Arm:** The global semiconductor and software design company has more than 80 employees in Chandler. ARM has continued to grow its operations in Chandler since originally locating in 2016. In 2018, ARM more than doubled its footprint here by leasing a 33,000 SF space in the Price Corridor.

ANALOG DEVICES **Analog Devices:** Has approximately 100 employees between its facilities in Uptown Chandler and West Chandler. Analog Devices designs and manufactures integrated circuits for the automotive, industrial, communications, consumer, and computing markets.

isola **Isola:** Headquartered in Chandler with approximately 125 employees. Isola recently expanded/relocated to a 118,000 SF building in West Chandler. The company is a market leader in copper-clad laminates and dielectric prepreg materials used to fabricate advanced multilayer printed circuit boards (PCBs).

ADVANCED CIRCUITS **Advanced Circuits:** Has approximately 130 employees in West Chandler, where it recently relocated to a new 50,000 SF facility. Advanced Circuits manufactures Printed Circuit Boards for a diversified customer base that includes military, aerospace, and commercial users.

ASML **ASML:** Has approximately 300 employees in the Price Corridor and plans for growth. ASML provides chipmakers with hardware, software and services to mass produce patterns on silicon through lithography. ASML sells lithography machines to most of the major semiconductor manufacturers across the world.

WaveOptics **Wave Optics:** Has approximately 60 employees in West Chandler. Wave Optics designs advanced microdisplay drive architecture platform for video pipeline optimization and system integration that enables emerging microLED technology for augmented reality and mixed reality experiences.



Rogers Corporation: Has operated in Chandler for more than 50 years and has approximately 450 employees. The engineered materials solutions firm relocated its headquarters to Chandler in 2017. Rogers has facilities in both the Price Corridor and West Chandler.

Yield Engineering Systems: Building out a 123,000 SF Technology Center in the Price Corridor. YES develops and manufactures thermal, deposition, and wet process equipment that is used in semiconductor, life sciences, and display manufacturing. YES plans to have 100 jobs based at the facility.



EMD Electronics: Has opened a 75,000 SF factory in the Airpark Area to manufacture equipment for its Delivery Systems & Services business, which supplies delivery systems for gases and chemicals used in the semiconductor and display industries. The facility will support 100 jobs at full ramp-up.



Edwards: The leading supplier of vacuum and abatement services and solutions to the global semiconductor industry has opened a 200,000 SF facility in the Airpark Area that will support up to 200 jobs. Work at the new facility includes the remanufacturing and assembly of vacuum pumps used in semiconductor fabs.



VIAVI: The global leader in network test, monitoring and assurance solutions has relocated its headquarters to the Price Corridor and opened a 104,000 SF manufacturing facility in the Airpark Area for its Optical Security and Performance Products segment. The combined operations will support up to 230 jobs.



Advantest: Has purchased a building and land in West Chandler, submitted plans and broke ground on a phased, multi-facility project that will support up to 400 jobs. Advantest is a leading supplier of semiconductor final-test, system-level test sockets and thermal control units.
