



# Registered Independent Voters

## Methods to Cast a Vote in the Primary Election

---

### ACTIVE EARLY VOTING LIST (AEVL) – REGISTERED INDEPENDENT VOTERS

All AEVL voters will receive a postcard in the mail starting May 4th.

- On the postcard registered Independent voters must indicate if they would prefer to receive the ballot for the: Democrat race, or Republican race, or City of Chandler issues only ballot
- Drop the postcard in the mail and the ballot you've requested will be mailed to you.

Registered Independent voters on the AEVL who do not choose a ballot and do not mail the postcard back, will not receive a Primary Election ballot.

City of Chandler measures will appear on the ballot for both parties, so all Chandler voters will be able to vote on City issues and City Council candidates.

### EARLY VOTING BALLOT REQUEST – REGISTERED INDEPENDENT VOTERS

As a registered Independent voter you will be asked to pick which ballot you would like to receive:

- Democrat race, or
- Republican race, or
- City of Chandler issues only ballot.

The last day to request an early ballot be mailed is: July 22nd.

### ON-SITE EARLY VOTING

Voters can vote in-person, get a replacement ballot, or drop off their voted ballot at an on-site early voting location July 6 – 29, and on Election Day – August 2nd.
