

# Manufacturing



## 1980

**Intel** begins its first operations in Chandler. With 10,000+ employees here today, Intel manufactures **microprocessors** that power data centers and smart devices worldwide.

## 1987

**Microchip Technology** is founded after General Instrument spins off its microelectronics division. Today, the Fortune 1000 company is headquartered in Chandler and produces **microcontrollers** and **analog semiconductors**.

## 2004

Motorola spins off its semiconductor business into **Freescale Semiconductor**, a manufacturing operation located in the City until its acquisition more than a decade later.

## 2015

**NXP Semiconductors** acquires Freescale Semiconductors. NXP now has a campus in Chandler with ~1,700 employees.

## 2018

Global technology company **Northrop Grumman** acquires Orbital ATK. Today, its Launch Vehicles Division is headquartered in Chandler and will be expanding to a 617,000 square-foot campus here in November 2019.



## 1967

**Rogers Corporation** opens in Chandler. Today, the corporation is a global leader in **engineered material solutions** and has established Chandler as its corporate HQ and continues to grow its local engineering operations.

## 1985

**Motorola** establishes a presence in Chandler producing computer chips and other technology.

## 1990

**Orbital ATK**, a global leader in aerospace and defense manufacturing, opens facilities Chandler.

## 2008

**Everspin Technologies**, a semiconductor manufacturer specializing in Magnetoresistive RAM (**MRAM**) and Spin-Torque MRAM, grows out of a division of Freescale Semiconductor.

## 2018

Rogers Corporation expands its presence on the City's Price Corridor to support its **Advanced Connectivity Solutions** (ACS) segment, further expanding the company's manufacturing footprint in Chandler.

## 2019

**Isola Group** relocates its headquarters, R&D and manufacturing operations to a 119,000 square-foot industrial space in the Lotus Project.
