




Project Background

- Design consistent with 2019 Transportation Master Plan Update to complete the roadway improvements and meet the City's minor arterial design standard
- Minor arterial design standard calls for four lanes of travel with bike lanes
- Utilizing federal funding for design and construction so must comply with FHWA and ADOT guidelines

Project Limits




Project Overview

- Hunt Highway to Doral Dr
 - Widen to four lanes
- Doral Dr to Karsten Dr
 - Widen west side of Lindsay Road
- Riggs Rd to Ocotillo Rd
 - Widen east side of Lindsay Road
- Riggs Rd Intersection
 - Widen to add dual left turn lanes on Lindsay Road

Proposed Improvements

- Four vehicular travel lanes (two lanes in each direction)
- Raised medians and on-street bike lanes
- Curb, gutter, sidewalk, and ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) ramp upgrades
- Traffic signal upgrades and street lighting improvements
- Conversion of SRP 12kV overhead electric power to underground
- Drainage improvements
- Landscaping
- Intersection improvements at Riggs Road to dual left turn lanes

- Consider Community Comments/Design Progress
 - December 2021
- City Transportation Commission Meeting
 - January 2022
- City Council Meeting for Alignment Approval
 - January 2022
- Environmental Investigation Underway
 - Clearance Fall 2022
- Right-of-Way/Easement Acquisition Process
 - Scheduled to begin Fall 2022 (subject to environmental clearance)
- Construction Begins
 - Tentatively Summer 2024
