


Existing Neighborhood Park Improvements

Backbone of Chandler's park system

- **City's Goal:**
 - 1 neighborhood park per each square mile of residential development.
- **51 Existing Neighborhood Parks**
 - +1 Homestead North Park
- 67% of Chandler's Parks are 20 + years old
- Provide and equitable distribution of neighborhood park improvements throughout the city.
- **Improvements include:**
 - Playgrounds
 - Playground shade
 - Irrigation
 - Sport courts
 - Ramadas
 - Landscaping







Snedigar Sportsplex


- 90-acre Community Park



 - Splash pad improvements




Homestead North Park Homestead South Park

- Neighborhood Park
- 10.97 acres
- Acquired in 2005
- Completed in 2014
 - Shaded Playground
 - Sand volleyball court
 - Basketball court
 - Ramadas
 - Open turf space
 - Landscaping
 - Lighted pedestrian paths







Boys and Girls Club

Previous facility = 27,000 sq ft (1970's) Seton High

City purchased the facility in 1990 East Valley Boys and Girls Club

New facility completed in 2009 31,000 sq ft Gymnasium Meeting rooms Multi-purpose rooms Computer lab Office space
