

ORDINANCE NO. 2176

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHANDLER, ARIZONA, ADDING ARTICLE VI TO CHAPTER 17A, TO THE CHANDLER CITY CODE ESTABLISHING THE MAYOR'S COMMITTEE FOR THE AGING.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Chandler, Arizona as follows:

Section 1. That the Chandler City Code is amended by adding Article VI to Chapter 17A, entitled "Mayor's Committee For the Aging", read as follows:

ARTICLE IV. MAYOR'S COMMITTEE FOR THE AGING.

Section 17A-43. Creation of the committee.

a) There is hereby established a Mayor's Committee for the Aging, consisting of seven (7) members. This committee shall represent a cross section of the community. The seven (7) members shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the City Council.

b) At least six (6) of the regular members of the committee must be qualified electors of the city and have been residents of the city for at least one (1) year immediately preceding the date of appointment. One (1) member who is not a resident may be eligible to serve on the committee provided he is a resident of the local metropolitan area for at least one (1) year immediately preceding the date of appointment.

Section 17A-44. Terms of office, officers of board.

The terms of office for the regular members of the board shall be for three (3) years, except that the first members of the board shall be appointed for the following terms: Two (2) members shall serve for one (1) year; two (2) members shall serve for two (2) years; and three (3) members shall serve for three (3) years. Thereafter, their successors shall serve a full term.

The committee shall elect its own officers at the first meeting following the first of May of each year. The Development and Community Services Director, or duly authorized representative, shall act as secretary of the committee but shall not be allowed to vote. No officer elected by the board shall serve in the same capacity for more than two (2) consecutive one year terms.

Section 17A-45. Powers and duties generally.

The powers and duties of the Mayor's Committee for the Aging shall be:

a) To adopt such rules of procedure for the faithful performance of its duties.

b) To provide that four (4) members shall constitute a quorum and that the affirmative vote of the majority of members present shall be required for passage of any matter before the committee.

c) To assist and advise the city council on essential policies, rules and regulations relating to advocacy issues experienced by the aging of our community, such as accessibility, adult day care, and volunteerism.

d) To serve as liason between the city council and the general community in matters regarding the aging and to promote and advocate for the elderly whenever and wherever possible.
