

The City Clerk serves as the filing officer for all local election forms. All forms must be filed with the City Clerk within the deadlines noted in the Arizona Revised Statutes.

Candidates are encouraged to refer to the Arizona State Constitution, Arizona Revised Statutes, Chandler City Charter and City Code for legal requirements pertaining to candidates for elective office.

Running for Office as a Write-In

Chandler City Council

Candidate Eligibility

- Qualified elector
- Resident of City or annexed area for at least 2 years
- Hold no other elected office or City employment
- Did not previously file nomination paperwork and failed to submit a sufficient number of valid signatures,
- Did not withdraw from the Primary Election after a petition challenge in court, or removed from the Primary Election ballot or otherwise found to be ineligible by a court

Nomination Paper & Financial Disclosure

You must file a Nomination Paper that includes the Declaration of Qualification and Financial Disclosure Statement anytime from **March 2**, **2024** through **June 20**, **2024**.

Nomination Petitions

Write-in candidates are not required to file nomination petitions.

Campaign Finance Statement of Organization

You must file a Statement of Organization for Political Committees within 10 days of receiving contributions or making expenditures, in any combination, of at least \$500 in connection with your candidacy.
