Dignity Health to Leave AZ Blue Network

Dignity Health gave notice of its intent to leave the network effective February 1, 2024. We worked hard to keep Dignity Health in the AZ Blue network, but they repeatedly rejected our many offers of fair increases.

Members Will Get the Care That They Need

- 1. Emergency room visits are covered at the in-network level.
- 2. You can complete in-process treatment and hospital stays as in network.
- 3. There are ample in-network options where you can get the care you need. **Each Dignity hospital** has an in-network alternative within about 3 miles.

This does **NOT** impact members in FEP, Medicare Advantage, Individual and Family Affordable Care Act Plans, or ACA StandardHealth with Health Choice. Yavapai Regional Medical Center and Barrow Brain and Spine Medical Group have separate contracts and remain in-network.

AZ Blue Stands Up for Affordability

Providers should be paid fairly and deserve reasonable increases, but it is not OK to unnecessarily burden Arizona families in need of care.
