












CITY OF CHANDLER E-BIKE SAFETY AND POLICY



Know the rules, restrictions, and traffic laws governing electric bikes in the City of Chandler. Keep our sidewalks, paths, and streets safe for everyone.

SAFETY GUIDE

Yield to Pedestrians: E-bike riders must always yield the right-of-way to pedestrians on sidewalks, crosswalks, and shared-use paths.

Slow Down to Pass: Class 1 & 2 e-bikes must slow to a maximum speed of 5 mph when passing any pedestrian on a pathway.

Give Audible Warnings: Use bell, horn, or clear verbal warning before passing pedestrians or other riders from behind.

LAWS AND PENALTIES

Joint Parental Liability: Parents or legal guardians are held jointly liable for any fines imposed upon minors for e-bike violations.

Helmet Requirements: Mandatory for all e-bike riders under 18.

Night Riding: E-bikes must have a headlight and a red rear reflector.

Canal Paths: E-bikes of any class are prohibited on all canal paths.

Observe All Traffic Laws: Traffic laws apply to e-bikes operated in Chandler (**Chandler Ordinance 5164**)
