

- 1. INSTALLATION PER CITY OF CHANDLER STREET LIGHTING STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- 2. THE DEVELOPER SHALL COORDINATE ALL STREET LIGHT PLANS WITH APS. CONTACT THE APS CUSTOMER SERVICE REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE AT 602-493-4433.
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR WILL COORDINATE HIS WORK WITH THE APS LIGHTING DIVISION PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION.
- 4. STREET LIGHT CONDUCTOR TRENCHES WILL NOT BE BACKFILLED UNTIL INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY OFFSITE INSPECTOR.
- 5. ANY VARIANCE TO AN APPROVED LUMINARE SHALL REQUIRE A NEW DESIGN ACCOMPANIED WITH POINT-TO-POINT LIGHTING CALCULATIONS AT TEN FOOT INTERVALS INDICATING MAINTAINED FOOTCANDLE LEVELS BETWEEN LUMINARIES AND ACROSS THE WIDTH OF THE ROADWAY FOR APPROVAL BY THE CITY TRANSPORTATION ENGINEER.
- 6. POLES SHALL BE SET NO CLOSER THAN 2 ½ FEET FROM BACK OF CURB AND 1 FOOT FROM EXISTING OR PROPOSED SIDEWALK.
- 7. THE JUNCTION BOX NEAREST A POLE SHALL BE LOCATED OUT OF THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY IN A PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE STREETLIGHT OUTAGE TO NO MORE THAN 3 CALENDAR DAYS.
